

## **AS WE GATHER**

A battle has been raging over the centuries between those who ignore the hard truth that we are sinners, hopeless by ourselves, and those who have realized the real good that our Lord has graciously won for us. At the time of Jeremiah, self-proclaimed prophets such as Hananiah preached a false peace even as Israel was in exile in Babylon. In Paul’s day, members of the Early Church thought freedom from God’s Law meant they could ignore it. And when Jesus was calling new disciples, He warned that following Him would mean “a sword” coming between them and even members of their families. In Christ, the peace that only God can bestow has been given to us by grace. Because of the truly good news of Jesus’ death and resurrection, we can face the hard truth of our sinfulness and then sing with the psalmist of the real good, “the steadfast love of the Lord, forever” (Psalm 89:1).

May the LORD do so; may the LORD make the words that you have prophesied come true, and bring back to this place from Babylon the vessels of the house of the LORD, and all the exiles. <sup>7</sup> Yet hear now this word that I speak in your hearing and in the hearing of all the people. <sup>8</sup> The prophets who preceded you and me from ancient times prophesied war, famine, and pestilence against many countries and great kingdoms. <sup>9</sup> As for the prophet who prophesies peace, when the word of that prophet comes to pass, then it will be known that the LORD has truly sent the prophet.”

## CONFESSION

Pastor: The Jewish people were in exile far from the Promised Land, a punishment for disobeying God, when Jeremiah confronted Hananiah.

People: **And we are in exile between Eden and paradise, disobedient children of Adam, one and all.**

Pastor: People listened to the false promises of Hananiah.

People: **We, too, are guilty of listening to the false promises of the devil. The truth is hard, and we are sorry. Forgive us.**

Pastor:            Plead my cause and redeem me;

### **FORGIVENESS**

Pastor:            Political peace came for Israel when God allowed Cyrus to let the people return, and eternal peace was made possible for us and all people when our Lord Jesus paid for all sin, offering Himself on the cross in our stead. For His sake you are forgiven. What is real by the grace of God is always good.

**People:**            **Amen. Thanks be to God.**

### **EPISTLE**            *Romans 7:1–13*

Or do you not know, brothers—for I am speaking to those who know the law—that the law is binding on a person only as long as he lives? <sup>2</sup>For a married woman is bound by law to her husband while he lives, but if her husband dies she is released from the law of marriage. <sup>3</sup>Accordingly, she will be called an adulteress if she lives with another man while her husband is alive. But if her husband dies, she is free from that law, and if she marries another man she is not an adulteress. <sup>4</sup>Likewise, my brothers, you also have died to the law through the body of Christ, so that you may belong to another, to him who has been raised from the dead, in order that we may bear fruit for God. <sup>5</sup>For while we were living in the flesh, our sinful passions, aroused by the law, were at work in our members to bear fruit for death. <sup>6</sup>But now we are released from the law, having died to that which held us captive, so that we serve in the new way of the Spirit and not in the old way of the written code. <sup>7</sup>What then shall we say? That the law is sin? By no means! Yet if it had not been for the law, I would not have known sin. For I would not have known what it is to covet if the law had not said, “You shall not covet.” <sup>8</sup>But sin, seizing an opportunity through the commandment, produced in me all kinds of covetousness. For apart from the law, sin lies dead. <sup>9</sup>I was once alive apart from the law, but when the commandment came, sin came alive and I died. <sup>10</sup>The very commandment that promised life proved to be death to me. <sup>11</sup>For sin, seizing an opportunity through the commandment, deceived me and through it killed me. <sup>12</sup>So the law is holy, and the commandment is holy and righteous and good. <sup>13</sup>Did that which is good, then, bring death to me? By no means! It was sin, producing death in me through what is good, in order that sin might be shown to be sin, and through the commandment might become sinful beyond measure.

Lector:            This is the Word of the Lord.  
**People:**            **Thanks be to God.**

## CONFESSION

Pastor: Paul here announces that our incorporation into the Body of Christ frees us from our captivity to the Law. That is why Paul points out that we cannot recognize sin without its being condemned in the Law.

**People: Looking into the mirror of the Law, we recognize that we have become “sinful beyond measure.” The truth is hard, and we are sorry. Forgive us.**

**PSALM** *Psalm 119:155–156*

Pastor: Salvation is far from the wicked,

**People: for they do not seek Your statutes.**

Pastor: Great is your mercy, O LORD;

**People: give me life according to Your just decrees.**

## FORGIVENESS

Pastor: The severity of the Law, which ought to have been meted out against us, was poured out on our Lord on the cross. The freedom we have is to “bear fruit for God,” who raised Him from the dead. Because of Christ’s victory you are forgiven. What is real by the grace of God is always good.

**People: Amen. Thanks be to God.**

*(Congregation stands)*

**HOLY GOSPEL** *Matthew 10:34–42*

Pastor: The Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew, the tenth chapter.

**People: Glory to You, O Lord.**

<sup>34</sup> “Do not think that I have come to bring peace to the earth. I have not come to bring peace, but a sword. <sup>35</sup> For I have come to set a man against his father, and a daughter against her mother, and a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law. <sup>36</sup> And a person's enemies will be those of his own household. <sup>37</sup> Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me, and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. <sup>38</sup> And whoever does not take his cross and follow me is not worthy of me. <sup>39</sup> Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. <sup>40</sup> “Whoever receives you receives me, and whoever receives me receives him who sent me. <sup>41</sup> The one who receives a prophet because he is a prophet will receive a prophet's reward, and the one who receives a righteous person because he is a righteous person will receive a righteous person's reward. <sup>42</sup> And whoever gives one of these little ones even a cup of cold water because he is a disciple, truly, I say to you, he will by no means lose his reward.”

Pastor: This is the Gospel of the Lord.

**People: Praise to You, O Christ.**

## CONFESSION

Pastor: Here our Lord makes clear the turmoil that following Him might entail. He calls us take up our crosses and even lose ourselves for His sake in order to find true life.

**People: But we are sinful in every way, not always putting You first. The truth is hard, and we are sorry. Forgive us.**

## PSALM *Psalms 119:157–160*

Pastor: Many are my persecutors and my adversaries,

**People: but I do not swerve from Your testimonies.**

Pastor: I look at the faithless with disgust,

**People: because they do not keep Your commands.**

Pastor: Consider how I love Your precepts!

**People: Give me life according to Your steadfast love.**

Pastor: The sum of Your word is truth,

**People: and every one of Your just and righteous decrees endures forever.**

## FORGIVENESS

Pastor: Our Lord grants us life according to His steadfast love and even rewards those who receive His imperfect followers. By the overflowing mercy of God you are forgiven. What is real by the grace of God is always good.

**"Lose His Life... Will Find It"**

Pastor Dan

*(Congregation stands)*

**CREED**

*Nicene Creed*

**People:**

**I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth and of all things visible and invisible.  
And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God, begotten of His Father before all worlds, God of God, Light of Light, very God of very God, begotten, not made, being of one substance with the Father, by whom all things were made; who for us men and for our salvation came down from heaven and was incarnate by the Holy Spirit of the virgin Mary and was made man; and was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate. He suffered and was buried. And the third day He rose again according to the Scriptures and ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of the Father. And He will come again with glory to judge both the living and the dead, whose kingdom will have no end.**

**And I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord and giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son together is worshiped and glorified, who spoke by the prophets. And I believe in one holy Christian and apostolic Church, I acknowledge one Baptism for the remission of sins, and I look for the resurrection of the dead and the life ☩ of the world to come. Amen.**

## **PRAYER OF THE CHURCH**

Pastor: Let us pray for the Church around the world and for all people in their various circumstances.

In Jeremiah's day, most of the Israelites were in exile in Babylon. Let us pray for people who are displaced from their homes, communities, and countries.

Heavenly Father, use humanitarian efforts on every level to supply what they lack, until the eyes of world's power brokers are open to see their plight and put people's needs above their own political aspirations. Lord, in Your mercy,

**People: hear our prayer.**

Pastor: Prophets regularly "prophesied war, famine, and pestilence." Let us pray for refugees from warfare, those who lack the basic necessities of life, and all who are dealing with long-term ills or sudden emergencies.

Lord Jesus, use compassionate people and agencies to provide food, clothing, and shelter where they are needed; guide emergency and medical professionals as they tend those under their care; and open our eyes to see opportunities in which we may serve. [*Specific petitions may be added.*] Lord, in Your mercy,

**People: hear our prayer.**

Pastor: Paul wrote that because we belong to one another in the Body of Christ and have died to the law, "we may bear fruit for God." Let us pray for ourselves and the Church wherever it gathers in Christ's name.

O Holy Spirit, strengthen us and our brothers and sisters around the world as we seek to give our lives in loving service to You, reaching out to the lost, strengthening the weak in faith, and rejoicing together as we receive the real good that comes to us through Word and Sacrament. Lord, in Your mercy,

**People: hear our prayer.**

Pastor: These and any other things You would have us ask, heavenly Father, grant to us for the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, our Lord, for we dearly desire to sing of the steadfast love of the Lord, now and forever.
